



Guitar for Confident Players

What is the course about?

This course will enable you to build on your existing knowledge of the guitar, learning a variety of open chords and barre chords. You will also learn about finger plucking, strumming and solo playing. Classical guitar and reading music will also be taught. The session is relaxed and self expression through music is encouraged.

What will I learn?

On successful completion of this course, learners should be able to:

- Demonstrate the ability to play a variety of chords, including barre chords
- Explain the use of all the parts of the guitar, ie; the strings, frets, fingering, tuning, bridges, and different types of guitar
- Read music in various formats, ie; tab, diagrams, stave.
- Demonstrate the ability to tune a guitar in various ways.
- Learn to teach myself music pieces and songs on my own.
- Play as part of a group.

Entry Requirements

A basic knowledge of the guitar.

What will I need to bring with me?

Learners will need to provide their own acoustic guitar.

How will I learn?

The following teaching methods (ways of supporting learning) will be used during this course: demonstration, one to one and group work, discussion, improvisation, working in pairs and as part of a group, hand outs and diagrams

How will my learning be assessed?

Learners' progress and achievements will be recognised and assessed in the following ways: self assessment forms to record progress, observation and tutor feedback and audio recordings, performance (formal/informal) and individual record of progress and achievement.
