



Performing Arts

What is the course about?

This practical course explores the various aspects of performing arts including devising performance material, improvisation, writing for theatre, drama exercises and games, acting and directing, set and costume design and stage management. You will work as an individual, in small groups and as part of the larger group.

What will I learn?

You will develop skills and understanding of various aspects of performing arts including: acting and performance, direction, writing and devising performance material, set design and costume, stage management and production.

Entry Requirements

No previous experience or qualifications required, just enthusiasm and a willingness to have a go. You will work on productions throughout the year, this entails commitment and responsibility as you will be working as part of the group.

What will I need to bring with me?

You don't need to bring anything with you.

How will I learn?

Through practical engagement with various aspects of performance including working through the stages of group performance production culminating in public performance.

How will my learning be assessed?

By yourself and the tutor in the form of discussion, observation, self and peer assessment.
