Sketching Out and About

What is the course about?

This six week course will give students the opportunity and confidence to sketch outside. (when it is not raining of course) We will work with dry media such as pencil or chalk and learners will make quick sketches before doing one or two longer drawings. Please note there will be a small amount of walking necessary with this course.

What will I learn?

Students will learn basic sketching techniques. Creating quick drawings to get the feel of the object or natural land shape they are going to draw and then learn about natural shadows. Learners will work in a group outside the class room when possible.

What will I need to bring with me?

We will provide basic materials but you may wish to bring your own pencils and chalk.

How will I learn?

You will learn through practical experience (having a go), tutor demonstration and one to one support. Learners will also get guidance through handouts.

How will my learning be assessed?

Learners' progress will be monitored and feedback offered by the tutor throughout the course. Self evaluation and final pieces of work will also support assessment.

What qualifications will I get?

There is no formal accreditation.
