



### Mini Ceramics

#### What is the course about?

This will be a six week course. You will be making really small figures or objects out of clay and through this develop your creativity, a style of working and basic practical skills in ceramics.

#### What will I learn?

You will learn to think quickly and creatively, expressing your ideas in 3 dimensions in clay. You will make something out of nothing in a very short space of time without feeling the pressure of having to create a great piece of art.

#### Entry Requirements

This course is open to all REMIT learners but is ideal for those with little experience of using clay or who find it hard to complete art work in a set period of time.

#### What will I need to bring with me?

Ideas and pictures you can use as inspiration.

#### How will I learn?

You will learn through demonstration by the tutor, one to one feedback and group discussion. We will also gain inspiration from artists and sculptors via handouts and the internet.

#### How will my learning be assessed?

Your progress will be assessed through ongoing one to one support, feedback, self assessment, observation by the tutor and final pieces of work.

#### What qualifications will I get?

There are no formal accreditation.
